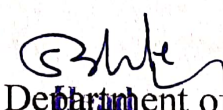

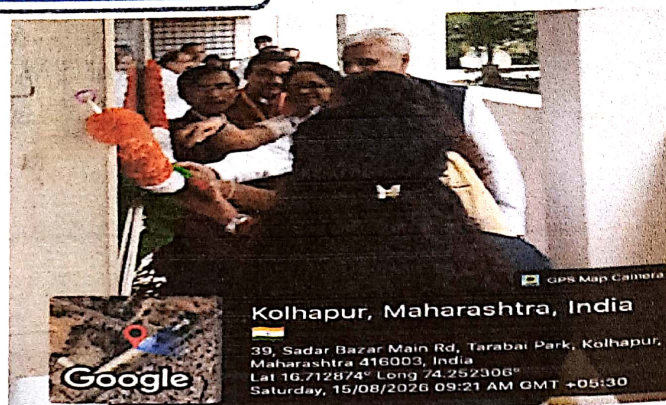

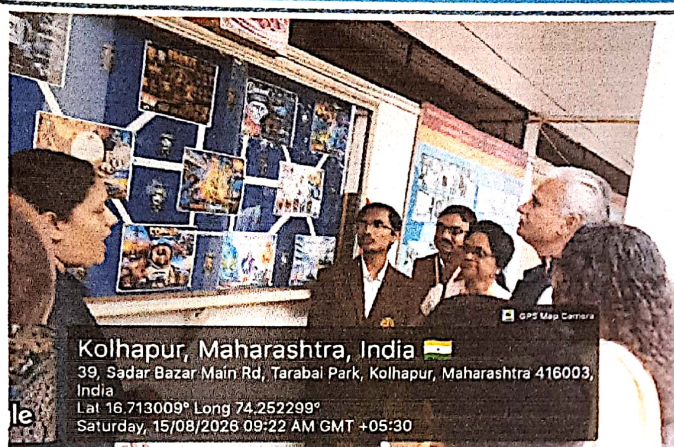
Outcomes of Wallpaper Activity:

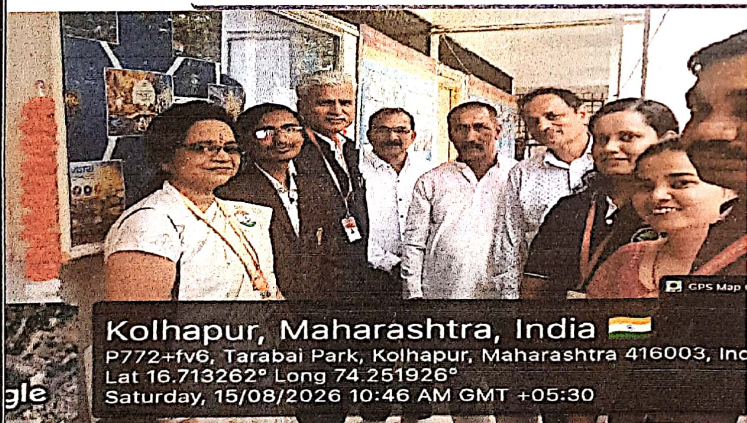
