Report

Shivaji University, Kolhapur and Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu College, Kolhapur jointly organized the National Service Scheme Special Residential Labor Camp at Rukadi, Tal. Hatkanangale, Dist. Kolhapur from 30th December, 2024 to 5th January 2025. The slogan of the camp was 'Swachha Bharat Abhiyan' (Clean India Campaign'). The camp was inaugurated by Hon. Mr. Sharad Memane, Police Inspector, Hatkanangale. Vice-Principal Dr. M. K. Kannade chaired the session. Mr. Manohar Hajare, Principal, Mahatma Gandhi Junior College, Rukadi, Mr. Tipule, B. B., Superintendent, Mahatma Gandhi Hostel, Rukadi were also present for the inauguration of the camp.

On the first day, instructions were given to volunteers about the camp and nature of work. Volunteers were divided into 6 groups and leaders were assigned to each group. Each group worked in turn and told their responsibility. Total 100 volunteers were actively participated in the camp.

The daily schedule of volunteers included prayer and exercise early in the morning; labour work and cleanliness activities at the different areas of the village; organization of expert lectures on different social issues and on personality development; group discussion on various topics, social awareness activities like, street plays, rally as well as organization of cultural program. Breakfast, lunch and dinner were provided to volunteers.

On second day of camp (31st Dec., 2024), a lecture of Mr. Babasaheb Nadaf, General Secretary, Rashtriya Seva Dal guided volunteers on Contribution of Youth in Nation Building. He guided volunteers about their role in social and national development.

On 1st January, 2025, Dr. Vivek Kotekar, Mind Trainer, Kolhapur delivered a lecture on 'Prosperity Mindset for Holistic Development'.
