



## Annual Report- 2021-22 Examination and Academic Development Committee

As per the guidelines given by CDC and IQAC, Examination and Academic Development Committee prepared an examination schedule which is incorporated in Academic Calendar. The Institution has offered B.A., B.COM, B.Sc., BCS, MA and M.Sc. programmes to the students. Examination schedule/annual calendar is a plan for conducting various internal evaluation examinations and tentative months of University Examinations. This allows the faculties to preplan the assessment procedures to be employed for each class. The schedule includes diagnostic test for first year students of all programs, unit tests and pre-semester examination. Unit tests were conducted at the department level whereas Pre-Semester Examination is conducted in an online mode through Google Forms. The internal evaluation is done as per the rubrics devised by the committee and results were prepared and shown to the students for further up gradation in their academic development.

A diagnostic test was conducted for 1<sup>st</sup> year students on 4/12/2021 in order to identify slow and advanced learners. All departments have taken two unit tests in each semester whereas online preliminary examination was conducted for the students of all classes during 17/01/2022 to 24/01/2022. All departments have maintained records of these examinations in their department. During first semester the MCQ examination of the 1<sup>st</sup> year students for the semester I (Fresh students) and II (Repeater students) is taken at institutional level in an online mode and results were communicated to the University; whereas, during 2<sup>nd</sup> semester these examinations (MCQ Type) were taken in an offline mode through centralized block-wise seating arrangement. The results of internal evaluation, i.e. Term Work, for UG and PG were prepared only of the last year students which is a part of University Examination. The study material for Non-CGPA courses is available on University website but the examinations of these Civic Courses - twice in a year for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students - were also conducted through online mode and results are communicated to the University within a stipulated period. Our institution followed the university norms and guidelines for conducting semester examinations. College had appointed junior supervisor senior supervisors and guided them for their work. The results of final year students of University Examination were remarkable. The result of B.Com-IT, B.Sc.-III, BCS-III and M.A.II were 100 %. The result of B.Com.-III was 98.85% whereas the result of B.A.-III was 92.47%. The result of M.Sc. II was 85.71%.
