

## Mechanism of testing entry level knowledge of students


Examination and Academic Development Committee informs to the faculty to prepare only 5 MCQs of concerned subject in a soft copy and mention the course outcome into the bracket after each question as well as the soft copy of the same should be sent on email of examination committee for conducting a diagnostic test. The committee compiles MCQs and prepares programme-wise single question paper. The committee also informs to the students of 1<sup>st</sup> year of all programmes about a diagnostic test at the beginning of academic year in order to test their primary level knowledge and information about the subjects which they have opted at the time of admission.

- Expectations from each department are to evaluate the test, prepare result and diagnose the students as advanced learners and slow learners and take special efforts for both the groups at departmental level with time table in order to give academic justice and proper guidance.
- Steps for Slow Learners may include Remedial Coaching, Home Assignments, Bridge Course, Special Lectures etc.
- Steps for Advanced Learners may include Seminar, Group Discussion, etc.
- Keep up to date record at departmental level for further process.
