Data Coding


Least is best method is used to code data. It means lowest rank is given to the strongly agree response and next rank is given to agree response and so on.

- 5) Strongly disagree : 5


Analysis of Feedback

Conclusion:

Feedback for teachers was analyzed and the opinion of the stakeholders is obtained about each parameter in terms of percentage. From feedback the conclusions are: the respondents are strongly agreeing with 72% and 69% for syllabus is suitable to the course and syllabus is need based. More than 62% and 63% respondents are strongly agreeing with aims and objectives of the syllabus are well defined and clear to teachers and students and Course content is followed by corresponding reference materials. About 91% and all respondents are agreeing with Sufficient numbers of prescribed books are available in the library and the course/ syllabus has good balance between theory and application.

The respondents are strongly agreeing with 61% and 63% for the course/ syllabus has made me interested in the subject area and the course/ syllabus of this subject increased my knowledge and perspective in the subject area. All respondents are satisfied with the course/ programmes of studies carry sufficient number of optional papers and the books prescribed/ listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and appropriate. About 90% respondents are agreeing Infrastructure facilities, such as teachers' rooms/carrels, class rooms, reading rooms are available in the department and Optimum canteen facility available at the College Campus.

All respondent is agreeing with Tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus, the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the syllabus, the freedom to adopt new techniques/ strategies of teaching such as seminar presentations, group discussion and learners' participation, the freedom to adopt/adapt new techniques/ strategies of testing and assessment of students, The environment in the department is conducive to teaching and research, The administration is teacher friendly, The institute provides

adequate and smooth support for projects and research facilities, The institute provides adequate funding and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications, Provisions for professional development are non-discriminatory and fair.
